

Do I need a Mould Inspection?

There are 1000's of types of mould species. While some are more dangerous than others, mouldy environments are linked with a vast array of diseases and health concerns, in addition to the structural damage to your property. Mycotoxic spores may be present in the air without any visible mould growth and if left unidentified, untreated and unchecked these can pose a serious health or public liability risk and potentially cost thousands to resolve and repair.

If you suspect you may have a mould problem but aren't sure, there are some tell-tale signs to look for:

Property Concerns

- ❖ A musty odour in certain rooms, chimney, air conditioners, etc
- ❖ Any visible mould growth including a fine whitish film on furniture
- Paint bubbling or pealing on wall or ceilings
- Known water leaks, water damage, wet areas, water staining
- Wood rot or soft spots on wood floors, walls or ceilings
- Exhaust fans or air conditioning systems frequently jammed

CIRS, Organ damage, or other chronic/life threatening conditions

Health Concerns

- Chronic fatigue or restless sleep
- Headaches
- Mood swings
- Itchy, red, watery eyes or blurred vision
- Skin irritation, rashes or hives
- Difficulty breathing or tight chest
- Nausea or gastric complaints

- Memory loss
- Sinusitis / Nasal congestion
- Sneezing and Nosebleeds
- Cough or Sore throat
- Allergy symptoms
- Wheezing or Asthma symptoms
- Hallucinations
