

Homeowner's Guide to Mould Prevention

- Keep roof & gutters clean and repair any leaks immediately.
- Ensure roof cavities & sub floors are well ventilated
- Install security screens to allow windows to remain open and well ventilated.
- Exhaust fans & rangehoods should be regularly cleaned and vent to the outside of the home where possible.
- Exhaust fans in bathrooms should be used during all showering/bathing.
 Run fans for at least 15 min after use.
- Exhaust fans in the kitchen should be used during all cooking activities and vent to the outside of the home where possible.

- **❖** Keep air conditioning units in good working order.
- Clean air conditioners at least once per year.
- Run air conditioners on dry cycle to minimize moisture levels
- Keep gardens well maintained and avoid plants and shrubs growing against or too close to the home.
- Install extraction ventilation in the laundry to reduce water vapour and condensation build up.
- Keep the home clean and avoid dust build up to minimize mould growth.
