Tenant's Guide to Mould Prevention

- ❖ Open windows regularly
- ❖ Open blinds/curtains regularly
- ❖ Open windows during and after a shower/bath to remove moisture
- ❖ Regularly check and clean exhaust fans for dust & blockages
- ❖ Dry clothes outdoors to reduce moisture build up
- ❖ Report broken exhaust fans, extractors, rangehoods & air conditioners immediately
- ❖ Keep indoor plant to a minimum & maintain gardens. keep plants & shrubs away from the home
- ❖ If you do find mould in the home, immediately report the issue to your real estate or property manager to have the issue inspected and resolved
- ❖ Keep furniture away from walls
- ❖ Close windows when raining
- ❖ Run exhaust fans during showers and for 30min after finished
- ❖ Always use kitchen exhaust fan when cooking
- ❖ Open windows/doors if using a clothes dryer
- ❖ Keep the home clean and avoid dust build up to minimize mould growth
- ❖ Use dehumidifiers or air conditioners on dry cycle to reduce moisture in the home
